SPEAK TO A CAREERS CONSULTANT

The Careers and Employability Centre offers daily 30 minute appointments, bookable in advance, as well as 15 minute drop in sessions which operate on a first come first serve basis. For students unable to attend sessions on campus, telephone and face-time appointments can be arranged in addition to the weekly webchat service currently offered.
