

Disability and Dyslexia Centre

Guidance for Medical Evidence

The Disability and Dyslexia Centre requires evidence to support reasonable adjustments and an application for Disabled Students' Allowance (if applicable).

The Letter Should:

- State your diagnosis
- State whether your condition is long or short term
- State whether your condition fluctuates
- Outline the effect your condition may have on learning/attendance at University
- State the impact, if any, on day-to-day activities

Ideally, the letter should also state whether any of the following are affected:

- Concentration
- Motivation
- Short term/long term memory
- Mobility
- Ability to travel on public transport
- Reading/writing for long periods
- Use of computers

The above list is not exhaustive but gives examples of the kind of evidence required.

If there is a charge for supplying medical evidence this can be covered by the Disability and Dyslexia Centre, although we will need a receipt.
